

- 9. <u>Liability</u> Yacht Owners (Including competing crews) are advised to ensure they are adequately covered for loss, damage or injury to persons, yachts or equipment at any time, however occuring. No responsibility will be accepted by the RL 24 Owners Association of Australia, or those Officials or Members connected with the Championship. All those taking part do so at their own risk.
- 10. <u>Safety Equipment</u> All boats must conform to the safety equipment as specified in the RL 24 Class Rules and Restrictions and also the prescriptions and safety regulations of the A.Y.F. All yachts must be equipped with a working auxiliary motor. Safety inspections may be carried out at random on any yacht competing in this championship.
- 11. <u>Identification</u> All yachts competing in the Championship must display Sail Numbers on Sails.

12. Social Activities

A "Welcome Night B-B-Q" on a B.Y.O. basis for Visitors will be held at 1900 hrs on Saturday January 12th 1980, at the Speers Point Amateur Sailing Club.

The Speers Point Amateur Sailing Club and B-B-Q facilities will be available over the period of the Championship.
