

NATIONAL TITLES 1989 are to be held at Lake Wellington, Victoria from the 7th to 14th January.

STATE TITLES 1988 are to be held at Lake Cootharaba over Easter so keep the date free on your calender. I will advise more as the details are made final.

WINTER SAILING. During the off season there has been two events that I have been associated with in which the RL24's did quite well. The first was the annual Bay to Bay, held from Tin Can Bay to Hervey Bay. 26 RL24's participated in this race and was the largest class entry out of 200 boats. Our class results were very favourable and competitive to the boats in our division. The RL24's were also out in force for the annual Wintersun which was held from Runaway Bay to Morton Bay. The class times from this race were also very good.

BOATS AND EQUIPMENT FOR SAIL. I releve quite a few phone calls inquiring about boats and second hand sails. As you could understand the boats as well as the sails are quickly snapped up, so I would apreciate members keeping me informed of items for sale. I also pass information onto the other state associations.

NEW MEMBERS. At present we have 35 boats on our register and I hope to enlarge on this considerably this season. I would appreciate members spreading the word about the association and also the state titles. With the 16 boats that we had participate in the state titles in 1987, we did the state class well and we should be able to improve on that even more.
