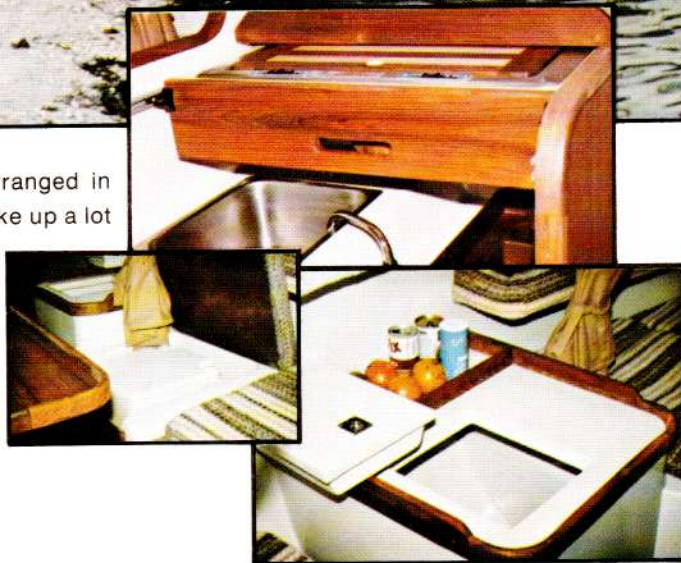
Designed to stand up to the punishment of the Australian Ocean, she is

equally at home on an inland lake where the shallow draft is especially useful. She is luxurious and loaded with standard equipment, economical to purchase and affordable to own.

The construction is unique. There are 16 small bulkheads, the hand laid sandwich construction and coremat used throughout the hull, achieves a tremendous combination of structural strength and lightness.



The creature comforts are arranged in such a way that they do not take up a lot of space. The stove slides back out of the way to expose the sink, and the porta-potti is concealed under part of the forward berth. Each is as convenient to use as the large centrally located ice box.



The fine woodwork and special touches like the spray shield and the self-bailing storage lockers, exemplify the high quality of workmanship and the attention to detail.

The forward vee berth forms a 6'10" double bed when the filler cushion is in position. This delightfully big area has the added benefit of two opening ports and a removable front hatch. The 5' drop leaf table services the entire family, and the two quarter berths are over 6' long.

The RL-24 is one of the most enjoyable and best performing trailerable yachts available. Her racing record is well established. She drives to windward with the power and stability of the heavier keel boats and yet off the wind she planes with the ease of a racing skiff.



The weight and design of the RL-24 make it possible for it to be trailered with ease behind today's smaller cars. Since it draws only 12" of water, it can be launched almost anywhere. The lightweight aluminum spars can be raised or lowered in minutes on a hinged tabernacle; reducing the workload, and adding to the enjoyment of your yachting experience.



The cabin is light and airy enough to be of use when under way. Yet with all of this room below the deck, the RL-24 still has a cockpit that comfortably accommodates six adults.

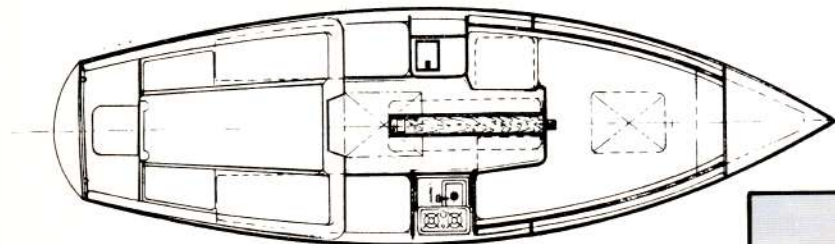
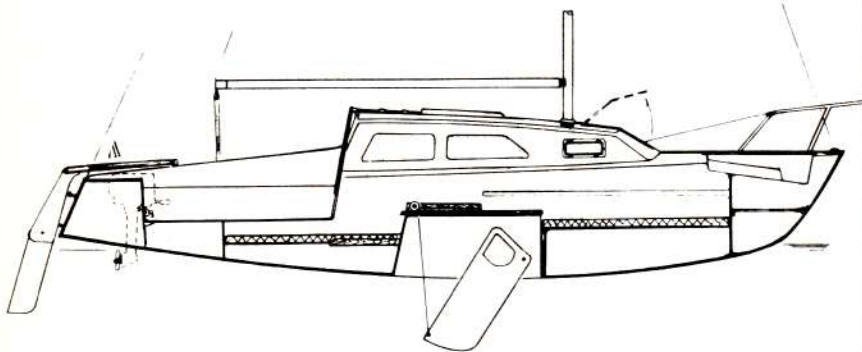
